The U.S. Department of Commerce's National Telecommunications and Information Administration announced it had awarded 15 grants to fund broadband mapping and planning activities, including in Tennessee. The agency awarded the state approximately \$1.3 million for broadband data collection and mapping activities over a two-year period and almost \$500,000 for broadband planning activities over a five-year period in Tennessee, bringing the total grant award to about \$1.8 million. Connected Tennessee is the designated entity for the state of Tennessee.
